musiconthemeadow 2007 (“mmm07”) declared another resounding success

The Trustees of musiconthemeadow (“mmm”) have today released the following statement:

“Once again the residents of Mayfield and the surrounding area enjoyed a spectacular day of musical and other entertainment during the 12 hour mmm07 festival that took place on Court Meadow, Mayfield on Saturday 14th July 2007.

Over 3,000 people attended the event throughout the day and were greeted with a wide range of music, starting with the final play-off of the “Battle of the Bands” competition in which local up and coming bands competed for the Monk Memorial Trophy. This year’s winners, “OffLimit”, came from Beacon Community College and in addition to the trophy were also awarded guitars by Fender uk – the competition’s sponsor. The evening climaxed with an outstanding performance from The Counterfeit Stones.

The aims of mmm continue to be to provide a great day out for all involved and to distribute surplus funds generated - through the mmm foundation - to worthy causes. The foundation has decided that the surplus from mmm07 will be distributed to Demelza Hospice Care for Children and Chestnut Tree House, both local charities who provide palliative care, respite care and support to children with progressive life-limiting conditions and their families. Further announcements about distributions will be made in due course over the coming months.
