musiconthemeadow 2005 makes first distributions to local causes

The Trustees of musiconthemeadow2005 (“mmm05”)¹ have released the following statement:

“As has been previously announced mmm05 generated a surplus of funds that has been set aside to be distributed for the benefit of the young people of the parish of Mayfield and Five Ashes.

The Trustees have considered a wide range of proposals for the allocation of this surplus in accordance with the stated aims of mmm05. We are pleased to announce that the first two distributions have now been unanimously agreed as follows:

- £800 has been allocated to the Mayfield Brass Band, a registered charity, to provide further musical instruments for aspiring local musicians within the band; and
- £800 has also been allocated to the Mayfield Pre-School, as a contribution towards their planned building works.

The Trustees will announce further distributions as soon as they are agreed ”.
